Local Students Receive Cash Scholarships As Winners Of Young Americanos Photo Contest **Winning Photos Unveiled During Special Reception at Mexic-Arte Museum**

Forty students from central Texas will receive over \$7,500 in cash scholarships and other prizes at a special 2:00 p.m. reception this afternoon at Mexic-Arte Museum, 419 Congress Avenue in Texas.
