

## Local Students Receive Cash Scholarships As Winners Of Young Americanos Photo Contest Winning Photos Unveiled During Special Reception at Mexic-Arte Museum

Forty students from central Texas will receive over \$7,500 in cash scholarships and other prizes at a special 2:00 p.m. reception this afternoon at Mexic-Arte Museum, 419 Congress Avenue in Texas. The students will receive their awards for their winning entries in the Young Americanos youth photography contest sponsored by Farmers Insurance and the Mexic-Arte Museum.

Receiving the \$1,000 Grand Prize cash scholarship will be David Saenz, a 12th-grader from S. F. Austin High School in Austin. His winning photo depicts a young boy participating in an Easter play.

Over 1,000 young people from throughout central Texas submitted photo entries as part of the Young Americanos competition, which encouraged students to photograph Latino culture in central Texas. Other winning photographs offer portraits of area Latinos of all ages while at work, play, in school and after school.

In all, there were 40 scholarship and honorable mention winners, representing Austin, Georgetown, Pflugerville, San Marcos and other area communities.
