"On July 25, 2009 at 10:00 a.m., at Qualcomm Stadium in San Diego, we will kick-off an unprecedented fire prevention program for San Diego County residents," explained Robert Woudstra, Farmers Insurance CEO. "A continued drought, thousands of acres of aged unburned brush throughout the County, and Santa Ana winds should put all San Diego County residents on high alert. These unprecedented conditions demand an unprecedented effort," noted Chief Ghio.

"Farmers thanks all San Diego Fire Chiefs, firefighters and volunteers who will participate in this first-ever fire prevention program. We are proud to be a part of a team effort that will help residents throughout the county be better prepared to protect their families and their properties against the ravages of fire," Woudstra added. "The DVD is in English with Spanish sub-titles and shows homeowners how to clear brush, explains proper building and landscaping, explains insurance coverage, how to inventory your home, and how to prepare an evacuation route for your family."

"A fire safe community begins at the individual level with every homeowner assessing their property risk and creating defensible space. An individual's efforts can influence his or her neighbors and take the preparedness concept to the community and regional level which is our ultimate objective with the Before the Threat public awareness campaign," said Ron Lane, Director of the San Diego County Office of Emergency Services. "Prepared individual residents will make a difference in the safety of their families and could mitigate potential damages to their property."
