"Farmers Life President White noted milestones in the founding and growth of the company since 1910.

- -- New World Life Insurance Company was founded by seven Spokane, Washington businessmen.
- -- The company was originally named Roman Catholic Life Insurance Company, but was soon renamed New World Life after the founders raised more than \$1 million and sold their first policy covering a \$20,000 mortgage on a church.
- In 1930 the growing company moved its Home Office from Spokane to Seattle and later in 1942, New World Life purchased the Alaska Building, the first Seattle skyscraper.
- -- The organization soon came to the attention of John C Tyler and Thomas E. Leavey, who founded Farmers Insurance company in 1928 and were thinking of adding a Life insurance provider for Farmers agents to help fill the needs of the average American family.
- -- In 1953, Farmers Underwriters Association purchased a 52 percent share of the life company. The company was renamed Farmers New World Life, and with the power of the Farmers agency force behind it, sales skyrocketed.
- -- In 1977, Farmers purchased the remainder of the outstanding shares and became full owners. In 1978, Farmers New World Life grew to 400,000 policies-in force with \$9 billion in in-force policies.
- -- In 1982, with innovative policies such as the VIP-100 (an increasing Whole Life plan) and the Farmers Universal Life fueling growth, the company moved into its new, custom-built five story office on Mercer Island.
- -- The company reached \$200 Billion Life insurance coverage in force in 2006, and continued to increase that every year since.

"Farmers Life has reached 100 years through its agents, management and employees growing the company by treating each customer as family," notes Farmers Group, Inc. Chairman of the Board and CEO of Zurich Americas, Paul N. Hopkins. "The company has grown by offering innovative new products, coupled with exemplary service to our customers. Also, the conservative financial approach to doing business, has allowed Farmers Life to grow into a financially strong company, ready to grow by meeting the challenges of the next century."

Farmers is a trade name and may refer to Farmers Group, Inc. or the Farmers Exchanges, as the case may be. Farmers Group, Inc., a management and holding company, along with its subsidiaries, is wholly owned by the Zurich Financial Services Group. The Farmers Exchanges are three reciprocal insurers (Farmers Insurance Exchange, Fire Insurance Exchange and Truck Insurance Exchange), including their subsidiaries and affiliates, owned by their policyholders, and managed by Farmers Group, Inc. and its subsidiaries.
