## Farmers Insurance Topping Ceremony for New Print Distribution Center and Office Building Set for May 26, 2010 365,000-Square-Foot Project Signals Farmers' Continued Growth in Michigan

"I am proud to announce that the expansion, when completed will include a 264,045-square-foot office building and a 100,000-square-foot print and distribution center, and will eventually bring up to 1,600 jobs to the state," noted Woudstra.

"There are 27 West Michigan firms assigned to this project, making up more than 90% of all construction subcontracts. Over the duration of construction more than 420 local construction workers will be employed on site because of this project. At the height of construction there will be more than 200 workers on site at once," Woudstra stated.

"Farmers has been in Michigan since 1949," noted Boshoven. "Today there are thousands of Farmers employees, agents and district managers all across Michigan. We're committed to making sure we have the best resources, training and job opportunities available to meet our customers' needs, now and in the future."
